Verse 18

مَثَلُ الَّذِينَ كَفَرُوا بِرَبِّهِمْ ۖ أَغْمَاطُهُمْ كَرَمَادٍ
اشْتَدَّتْ بِهِ الرِّيحُ فِي يَوْمٍ عَاصِفٍ ۖ لَا
يَقْدِرُونَ مِمَّا كَسَبُوا عَلَىٰ شَيْءٍ ۖ ذَٰلِكَ هُوَ
الضَّلَالُ الْبَعِيدُ

Similes in the Quran

- o The people of the Elephant

Sura al-Fil, verse 5

- o The Day of Judgment

Sura al-Qariah, verses 4-5

Actions like Ash

- Small, light in weight
- Scattered, not joined together
- Easily dispersed by wind and other factors
- Not attractive or very useful
- Cannot be gathered once the particles are dispersed.

o People will be raised according to their intentions.
