Verse 18 مَثَلُ الَّذِينَ كَفَرُوا بِرَبِّحِمْ ۞ أَعْمَاهُمْ كَرَمَادٍ اشْتَدَّتْ بِهِ الرِّيحُ فِي يَوْمٍ عَاصِفِ \ يَقْدِرُونَ مِمَّا كَسَبُوا عَلَىٰ شَيْءٍ \ ذَلِكَ هُوَ الضَّلااً
