## Verse 26

وَمَثَلُ كَلِمَةٍ خَبِيثَةٍ كَشَجَرَةٍ خَبِيثَةٍ  
اجْتُثَّتْ مِنْ فَوْقِ الْأَرْضِ  
مَا لَهَا مِنْ قَرَارٍ

- And the parable of an evil word is as an evil tree pulled up from the earth's surface; it has no stability.

## Examples of Negative words

- o Rude words that make people feel small
- o Unkind words that hurt others
- o Scornful words that put people down
- o Discouraging words that make people feel unhappy.
- o Negative words that increase stress and tension
- o Complaining words that do not show appreciation

# How to stop saying negative words

- Think of what God would think of you for saying it.
- Put yourself in the other person's shoes
- Ask yourself why you want to say such words.
- Think of the consequences of your words
- Fight the Shaytan who puts such words in your mind
- Replace the words with positive words
- Apologize and make amends if you say negative words.
