Hadiths from *Ghurar al-Hikam*

○ الصَّدِيقُ الصَّدُوقُ مَنْ نَصَحَكَ فِي غَيْبِكَ،

وَحَفِظَكَ فِي غَيْبِكَ، وَآثَرَكَ عَلَى نَفْسِهِ. – ص 67

○ A truthful friend is one who: advises you of your faults, protects (your dignity) in your absence, and gives you preference over himself

○ مَنْ صَاحِبَ الْعُقَلَاءِ وَقِرَّ – ص 73 (*wuqqira* is a passive verb)

○ One who accompanies the wise, is respected.

○ طَالِبُ لَأَدَبٍ أَحْزَمُ مِنْ طَالِبِ الذَّهَبِ. – ص 81

○ The seeker of good etiquette is wiser than the seeker of gold.

○ كُلُّ سِرٍّ عِنْدَ اللَّهِ عَلَانِيَةٌ. – ص 85

○ Every secret is manifest with Allah.
