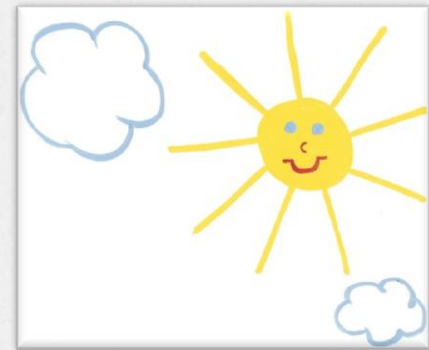

Why does the sun rise and set?

Polar Night and Midnight Sun

- Some places in the world experience complete days and complete nights for long periods of time.
- Alert, Canada is one such place. It is the most northern inhabited place on Earth.
- Being north of the Arctic Circle, Alert experiences **polar night** from the middle of October until the end of February and the **midnight sun** from the first week of April until the first week of September.
- There are two relatively short periods of twilight from about 13 February to 22 March and the second from 19 September to 22 October.
