Hadith on Quran

Three things will complain to Allah, The Noble and the Mighty, on the Day of Judgement:

- a deserted Masjid in which the people of the town did not recite Salat in it
- an 'Alim who was among the ignorant ones however the people did not make use of him
- the Qur'an which was not read and was left for dust to collect on it

Traveling in Islam

Islam recommends traveling.

The holy Quran says:

- قُلْ سِيرُوا فِي الْأَرْضِ ثُمَّ انظُرُوا كَيْفَ كَانَ عَاقِبَةُ
الْمُكْذِبِينَ

Say: Travel in the land, then see what was the end of those who reject (God).

Sura al-Anam, 6:11

Etiquette of Traveling

- 1) Dua before traveling (see next slide)
- 2) Praying while traveling (on the plane ..)
- 3) Halal meals
- 4) Qasr Salaat
- 5) Remembering Allah - appreciate the beauty of creation.
- 6) Good behavior - you are representing Islam

Dua for traveling

- الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي سَخَّرَ لَنَا هَذَا وَمَا كُنَّا لَهُ مُقْرِنِينَ وَإِنَّا إِلَىٰ رَبِّنَا لَمُنْقَلِبُونَ

All Praise is for Allah who has placed this (transport) at our service

and we ourselves would not have been capable of that and to our Lord is our final destination.
