HADITH OF THE DAY

SURAH ANBIYA VERSES 68-70

- COMPLETE TRUST IN ALLAH = HELP FROM ALLAH (*cooling of the fire and safety for Nabi Ibrahim*)

Other examples:

- STORY OF NABI MUSA AND FIRAUN
- STORY OF NABI NUH AND THE ARK
- HELP FROM ALLAH = SUCCESS

Trust in Allah

- **Tawakkul** refers to putting your trust in Allah – to believe that He alone can ward off the harms of this world, provide you blessings and sustenance, and to ease your challenges. **Tawakkul** is also about accepting the results that He decides regardless of how they may turn out to be.
- Keeping Allah in mind ALL the time
- Complete faith in Allah (*If we would only put our trust in Allah as we should, He would provide for us like He provides for the birds who fly out in the morning hungry and return fully satiated*)
- Full awareness that Allah has control over everything
- You work hard, strive and leave the rest to Allah
