The need for good character

- Natural and instinctive need
- Need for being a good servant of God
- Need for harmony in relationships
- Need for happiness in both worlds

Good Character

Positive qualities - kindness, courtesy, cheerfulness, helping others, respect, fairness, cleanliness . . .

Avoiding negative qualities- rudeness, lying, telling tales, jealousy . . .

Etiquettes - eating, drinking, sleeping, interacting with others . . .

Good habits – sleeping early, reciting Quran, helping at home, working hard . . .

Factors that influence character

- Genetics
- Behavior of parents
- Home atmosphere
- Friends
- Activities
- Media

Practical ways of molding character

Be clear

Have clear and concrete ideas of what type of characteristics you want to see in your child. Then communicate them well to your child. Show them examples, and walk through situations with them.

Use opportunities

Use natural situations to teach character. When opportunities arise, motivate and guide children to act with good character. That is practical and more effective than theoretical teaching.

Prophetic Reminders

- 1) Be a child with your children. The Holy Prophet (s) said: Whoever has a child should behave with him in a childlike manner.
- 2) Do not be upset at the crying of children. The Holy Prophet (s) said that one of the reasons why he loved children was that they cried often.
- 3) Kiss your children often, for with every kiss there is a rank in Heaven.
- 4) Increase the self esteem of your children by greeting them first. If they greet you, reply warmly.
- 5) Do not look down or make fun of childish behavior or childish emotions.
