# The Prophet (a): A servant of Allah

The Holy Prophet (s) always considered himself first a servant of Allah, then a Messenger of Allah.

When the Holy Prophet (s) occupied himself in prayer, he stood for so long that his feet were swollen. He was asked: "Allah's Messenger, you do this despite the fact that all your sins have been pardoned for you?"

He replied: "Should I not prove to be a thankful servant (of Allah)?"

# The Prophet: A Mercy to the worlds

وَمَا أَرْسَلْنَاكَ إِلَّا رَحْمَةً لِّلْعَالَمِينَ

*And We have not sent you but as a mercy to the worlds*

**Sura Anbiya, 21:107**

The Holy Prophet (s) was merciful to:

- his family
- children
- friends/believers
- non believers
- animals

# The Prophet (s) :A Listener

وَمِنْهُمْ الَّذِينَ يُؤْذُونَ النَّبِيَّ وَيَقُولُونَ هُوَ أَدْنَىٰ ج قُلْ  
أَذُنٌ خَيْرٌ لَّكُمْ يُؤْمِنُ بِاللَّهِ وَيُؤْمِنُ لِلْمُؤْمِنِينَ وَرَحْمَةٌ  
لِّلَّذِينَ آمَنُوا مِنْكُمْ

And there are some of them who trouble the Prophet and say: He is one who believes every thing that he hears; say: A hearer of good for you, (who) believes in Allah and believes the faithful and a mercy for those of you who believe.
