Hadith on the Quran

Lessons from the Story

- Nabi Sulayman (a) was organized and particular about things. From his huge army he noticed that one bird was missing.
- When someone does wrong, it is not right to accept it right away. That gives a wrong message, to them and to others.
- When reacting to wrong, first find out why it was done.
- Even though he was so powerful, Nabi Sulayman (a) was willing to listen to a small, weak bird.
