Hadith on the Quran

Three things will complain to Allah, The Noble and The Grand, (on the Day of Judgement):

- A deserted Masjid in which the people of the town did not recite Salat in it
- an 'Alim who was among the ignorant ones (however the people did not make use of him);
- and the Qur'an which was not read and was left for dust to collect on it.

Lessons from the Story

- Nabi Sulayman (a) had a large kingdom and a beautiful throne. But Hudhud shows him that there is someone else also who has been given a lot of things and who has a mighty throne. No-one should think they are the only ones granted abundance by God.
- Shaytan makes the actions of human beings seem good to them. He fools them into thinking what they are doing is right.
- The power and might of Allah cannot be compared to anything else. These verses show the greatness of Allah. How can people worship the sun instead of Allah?
