- Reaching high levels of potential fulfillment
- Being what God wants you to be
- Overcoming weaknesses and enhancing strengths
- Making the most of your circumstances
- Liberation from constraints of lust and physical pleasures
- Disciplining the self and becoming acquainted with higher ideas and a wider horizon

Desire for perfection

- The human being has a natural, innate love for perfection. This comes to the surface when opportunities arise.
- There is a desire to grow to the fullest capacity
