The Importance of Seeking Knowledge

- "Seek knowledge even if you have to go to China."
 - "Seeking knowledge is a *faridha* for every believing man and woman."
 - "The sleep of the learned man is greater than the worship of the ignorant man."

The Importance of Seeking Knowledge (2)

- When Allah (swt) speaks to the Prophet (68:4), he tells him: وَإِنَّكَ لَعَلى خُلُقٍ عَظِيم
- But in another verse (20:114), the Holy وَقُل رَّبٌ زِدْنِي عِلْمًا Prophet is ordered:

How is Knowledge Defined?

- Epistemology: the branch of philosophy which seeks the nature, sources and modes of knowledge
- Is the Islamic definition of knowledge different from others?
- Knowledge is that which leads us to fulfilling our purpose on the earth, or that which takes us closer to "knowing Allah (swt)."
 - اول الدين معرفته

How is Knowledge Defined (2)?

- In a narration, anything other than knowledge of God is فضل
- اللهم اني اعوذ بك من علم We recite in a supplication; لا ينفع

What are the Sources of Knowledge?

THE QUR'AN AND AHLUL BAYT ARE THE ONLY PURE SOURCES WHICH TAKE US TO PURE, CLEAR UNDERSTANDING

ALLAH (SWT) SAYS IN THE HOLY QUR'AN: "لا الأمطَة إلا الأمطَة (ONE CAN TOUCH IT (THE QUR'AN) EXCEPT FOR THE PURIFIED ONES"

ا عيش العدم IMAM ALI SAYS IN A NARRATION THAT AHLUL BAYT ARE و موت الجهل

The Sources of Knowledge (2)

- Imam Baqir (as) says, "Search to the east and the west and you will never find correct knowledge except that which has left this house!"
- The Prophet says, "I am the city of knowledge, and Ali is its gate."
- Abu Hanifa says, "If it were not for the two years (with Imam Sadiq), I would have perished..."

The Hadith of Unwan al-Basri

- Narrated in Bihar al-Anwar
- He was a 94 year old student of Malik bin Anas
- Desired to seek knowledge from Imam Sadiq (a)

The Hadith of Unwan al-Basri (2)

العلم نور يقذفه الله في قلب لمن يشاء ; The Imam tells him

Imam Sadiq's advices in seeking knowledge:

عبودية 1. Knowledge is attained through عبودية

2. Seek knowledge through practice

3. Ask God to grant you knowledge
