ALI 332: Islam 101 for Reverts – Session 3

Conditions of Wudhū

If the following are present, the wudhū will be correct, and if they are not present then it would be void (*bātil*)

- 1. The water for wudhū must be *tāhir* (ritually pure), and according to *Ihtiyāt Wājib*, there must not be any uncleanliness like the urine of a halal animal or pus in it.
- 2. The water for wudhū must be *Mubāh* (permissible for use), i.e. it is not stolen property.
- 3. The water for wudhū must be Mutlaq, i.e. not mixed with other items.
- 4. The container holding the water must be *Mubāh*.
- 5. The container holding the water must not be made of gold or silver, according to *Ihtiyāt Wājib*.
- 6. The parts of the body that are to be wiped or washed at the time of wudhū must be *tāhir*.
- 7. There must be no obstruction on the body that prevents the water from reaching the body.
- 8. The wudhū must be done with the *niyyat* of *qurbatan illalah* -nearness to Allah, and not for showing off [any other reason].
- 9. Succession & sequence (*Tartib*) in actions must be observed (as was explained earlier).
- 10. No unusual gap of time ($Muw\bar{a}l\bar{a}t$) in the actions (there should not be a big time gap between the actions of wudh \bar{u}).
- 11. One must not acquire the help of other people.
- 12. There should be no constraint in using the water.
- 13. There must be enough time to perform wudhū and to perform the salāt.

Upon completion of wudhū' say:

O Allah, I ask for perfection in wudhū, perfection in salāt and Your complete pleasure, and Paradise. Then say: اَخْتُدُ للهِ رَبِّ الْعَالَمِيْنَ followed by recitation of Sūrat al-Qadr three (3) times.

Wudhu is part of Divine Worship, so do not associate others

- 1) The Holy Prophet (s): Two things which I do not like to join others in their performance. Wudhu for it is from my prayers and my charity." (*Khisal* p. 33)
- 2) Amir al-Mu'minīn (a) while performing Wudhu, did not permit anybody to pour water for him. When asked he said: I do not like to include anybody in my worship (of Allah). Allah the Almighty says: فَمَنْ كَانَ يَرْجُو لِقَاءَ رَبِّهِ فَلْيَعْمَلُ عَمَلاً صَالِحاً وَ لا يُشْرِكُ بِعِبَادَةِ رَبِّهِ أَحْداً "Then whosoever desires to meet his Lord, then he must act righteously and not include anybody in the worship of his Lord." (18: 110) (Wasā'il, 1:477)
- 3) Imam Al-Ridhā (a): Here, I am performing Wudhu for Salat. And it is worship which I do not like to share with anybody (Al-Kāfī, 1:21)
