Shorter Method of Performing Tahajjud Prayer

If someone has only about fifteen minutes left before *Fajr* time begins, he can still perform all eleven rakā'at of Tahajjud Ṣalāt by following the shorter method prescribed below.

- 1). Say four prayers of two rakā'āt each as **Nāfilah of Night** like the normal morning prayers. Any suras can be recited after al-Ḥamd in these eight (2×4) rakā'āt. If you fear that you may not be able to complete the remaining three rakā'āt then only recite al-Ḥamd in these eight rakā'āt.
- 2). Say ten times يَا الله O Allah.
- 3). Now say two rakā'āt of **Shaf'a Prayer**. After al-Ḥamd recite al-Nās in the first rak'ah and al-Falaq in the second rak'ah.

Surat al-Nas with translation

In the Name of God, the All-beneficent, the All-merciful.

[®] Say, 'I seek the protection of the Lord of humans, [®] Sovereign of humans, [®] God of humans,

(B) From the evil of the sneaky tempter (B) who puts temptations into the breasts of humans, (B) From among the jinn and humans.'

Surat al-Falaq with translation

In the Name of God, the All-beneficent, the All-merciful.

① Say, 'I seek the protection of the Lord of the daybreak ② from the evil of what He has created, ③ and from the evil of the dark night when it settles

- (and from the evil of the witches who blow on knots, (and from the evil of the envious one when he envies.)
- 4). Now say one rak'ah **Witr Prayer** as follows: after niyyah, takbīr, sūra al-Ḥamd, recite sūra al-Tawhīd three times.

5). Now raise your hands in Qunut and recite <u>any supplication you know by heart</u>. You can simply recite *ṣalawāt* on the Prophet and his family (اَللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَىٰ كُمَّدٍ وَ ٱللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَىٰ كُمَّدٍ وَ ٱللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَىٰ كُمَّدٍ وَ ٱللهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَىٰ عُلَىٰ عُلَىٰ عُلَا لَهُ عَلَىٰ عَلَىٰ عُلَمْ عَلَىٰ عُلَمْ عَلَىٰ عُلَا عَلَىٰ عُلَمْ عَلَىٰ عَلَىٰ عُلَمْ عَلَىٰ عُلَمْ عَلَىٰ عَلَىٰ عُلَمْ عَلَىٰ عُلَمْ عَلَىٰ عَلَىٰ عُلَمْ عَلَىٰ عُلَمْ عَلَىٰ عُلَمْ عَلَىٰ عَلَىٰ عُلَمْ عَلَىٰ عَلَىٰ

O Allah! Forgive me, and all believers, male and female, and forgive all Muslims, male and female.

Then go to rukūʻ and complete the prayers normally.

The following are recommended in the Qunūt of Witr <u>based on how much time you</u> have on you before *Fajr* prayer:

5a). The passage that is most recommended is the recitation of *Kalimāt al-Faraj* as follow:

There is no god but Allah, the Forbearing the Noble. There is no god but Allah, the High, the Mighty. Glory be to the Lord of the seven heavens,

And the Lord of the seven earths, and what is in them, and what is between them, Lord of the Mighty throne, and praise be to Allah, the Lord of the universe.

5b). Then recite the supplication known as Du'ā al-Gharīq.

O Allah, O All-beneficent, O All-merciful, O Who changes the hearts, make my my heart firm on Your religion.

5c). Then ask for the forgiveness for all Muslims by saying three times:

O Allah! Forgive all believers, male and female, and forgive all Muslims, male and female.

5d). Now seek forgiveness for yourself by saying seventy times:

I seek forgiveness of Allāh my Lord and I turn to Him

5e). Then recite seven times:

This is the state of one who seeks refuge in You from the fire.

5f). Say at least ten times and if possible three hundred times الْعَقْوَ, i.e. 'O the Pardoner' and then say:

My Lord: forgive me and have mercy on me, and turn to me clemently. *Surely, You are the All-clement, the All-merciful.*

- 5g). Now complete the prayer normally by performing ruk \bar{u} , qiyām, two sajdahs with respective recitations, then tashhahud and salām.
- 5h). It is recommended to end the prayer with tasbīḥ al-zahrā'.

May the Almighty Allah accept your devotion and reward you amply for your prayers.

Tahajjud in less than 5 minutes

If you have less than five minutes on you before *Fajr* prayers then simply say:

Two rakā'at Shaf'a Prayers reciting sūra al-Nās after al-Ḥamd in the first rak 'ah and al-Falaq after al-Ḥamd in the second rak'ah. Do not recite Qunūt in this prayer.

Then say one Rak'ah Witr Prayer reciting sūra al-Tawḥīd once after al-Ḥamd and then simply say ṣalawāt (اَللَّهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلَى عُكَمَّدِ وَ آل مُحَمَّدِ) once in Qunūt followed by:

O Allah! Forgive me, and all believers, male and female, and forgive all Muslims, male and female.

Now complete your prayers normally.
