



## 10 Hadith on the month of Sha'ban

1) O People of Yathrib, I am Allah's Messenger to you and Sha'ban is my month. May Allah have mercy on the one who helps me regarding my month!

**Holy Prophet (s)**

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2) Sha'ban is my month, so fast in this month as a sign of love for your Prophet and to get closer to your Lord.

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3) Sha'ban is my month; whosoever fasts a day from my month, Paradise becomes obligatory for him.

**Holy Prophet (s)**

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4) One who fasts in Sha'bān out of love for the Messenger of Allah and to get closer to Allah, Allah loves him and showers His generosity upon him on the Day of Resurrection and makes Paradise obligatory for him.

**Imam Ali (a)**

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5) Whoever fasts on the **first** day of Sha'ban, Paradise is made obligatory to him definitely. Whoever fasts **two** days in Sha'ban Allah looks at him (kindly) every day and night in this world, and His look continues in the Paradise. Whoever fasts **three** days [in Sha'ban] will visit Allah in His 'arsh in His Paradise every day.

**Imam Ja'far as-Sadiq (a)**

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6) Whoever seeks forgiveness from Allah – the Blessed and Exalted, in Sha‘ban seventy times, Allah forgive his sins even if they were equal to the number of stars.

**Imam Ali al-Rida (a)**

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7) Whoever gives charity in the month of Sha‘ban, Allah will nurture it the way one of you nurtures until he will meet it on the Day of Judgment and it will be like the mountain of Uhud.

**Imam Ja‘far al-Sadiq (a)**

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8) The heavens are adorned on every Thursday in Sha‘ban, and the angels say; Our God, forgive those who fast in it, and answer their prayers.

**Holy Prophet (s)**

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9) The fast of Sha‘ban is good, but separate between them [Sha‘ban and Ramadan] by a day or two.

**Imam Ja‘far al-Sadiq (a)**

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10) Whoever fasts the last three days of Sha‘ban and joins it to the month of Ramadan, Allah will write for him [the reward of] two consecutive months.
