What are other words for Truth and  
Falsehood?

He sends down water from the sky whereat the valleys are flooded to the extent of their capacity, and the flood carries along a swelling foam. And from what they smelt in the fire for the purpose of making ornaments or wares, there arises a similar foam. That is how Allah compares **truth** and **falsehood**. As for the foam, it leaves as waste, and that which profits the people stays in the earth. That is how Allah draws comparisons.

- The best struggle is the word of Haq in front of a tyrant ruler. **Holy Prophet (s)**

2. So that the human being can discipline himself to choose the path of truth over falsehood despite its difficulties.
3. Spirituality and good deeds make the human being taste the sweetness of Truth
