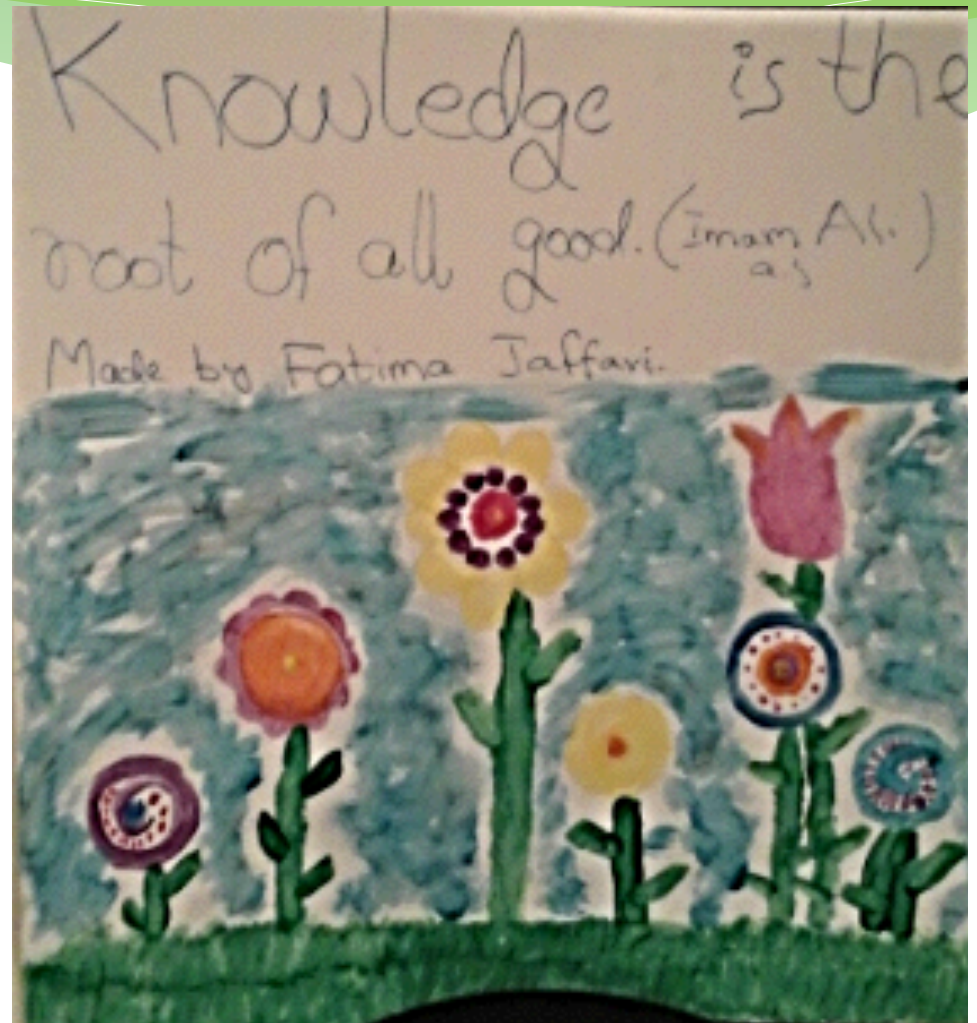
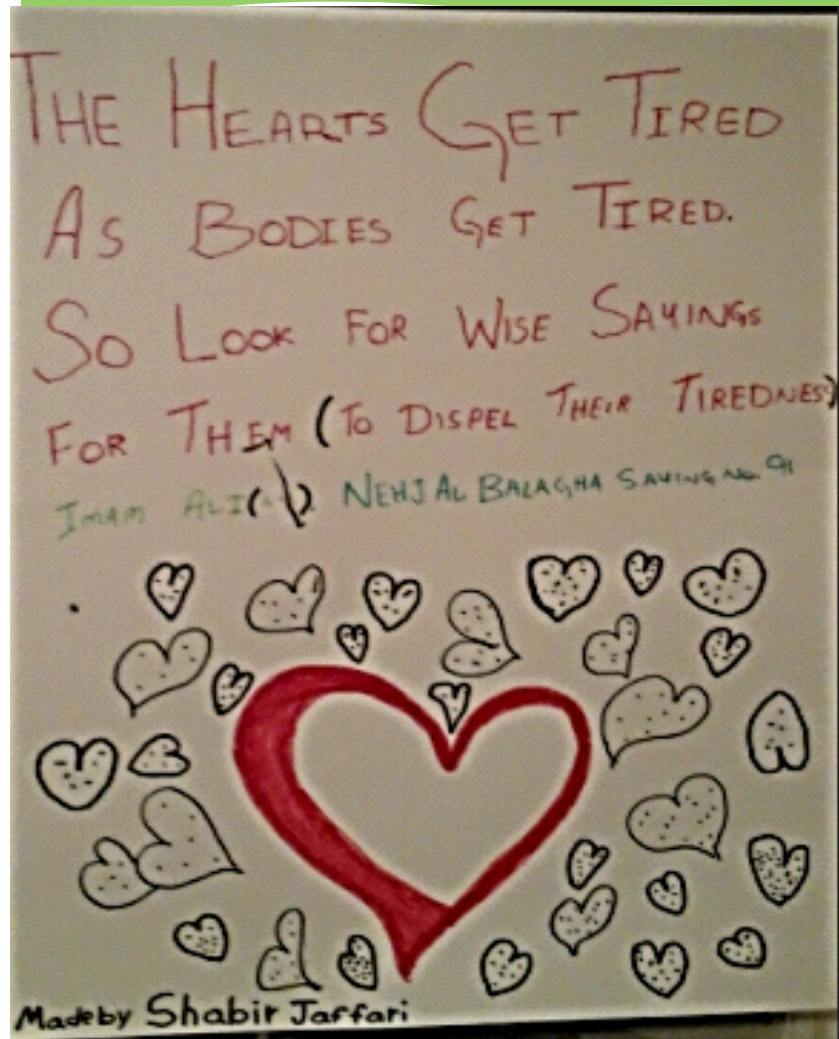
## Hadith n. 38 from Nahjul Balagha

- \* Amir al-mu'minin, peace be upon him, said to his son al- Hasan:
- \* 38. وقال عليه السلام : لابنه الحسن عليه السلام :
- \* O my son, **learn four things** and (a further) four things from me. **Nothing will harm you if you practise them.** That the richest of riches is intelligence; the biggest destitution is foolishness; the wildest wildness is vanity and the best achievement is goodness of the moral character.
- \* destitution=poverty vanity=excessive pride

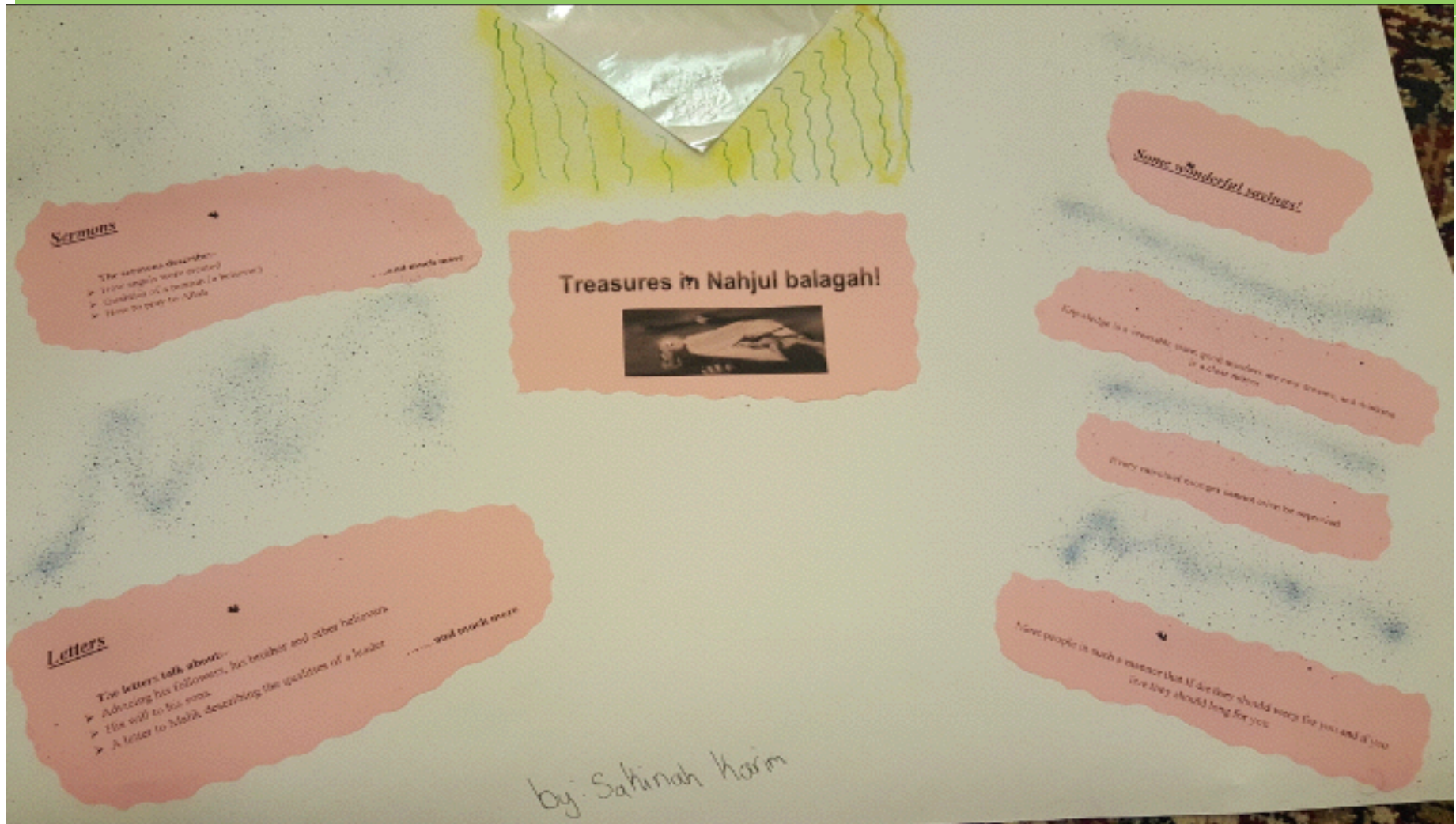

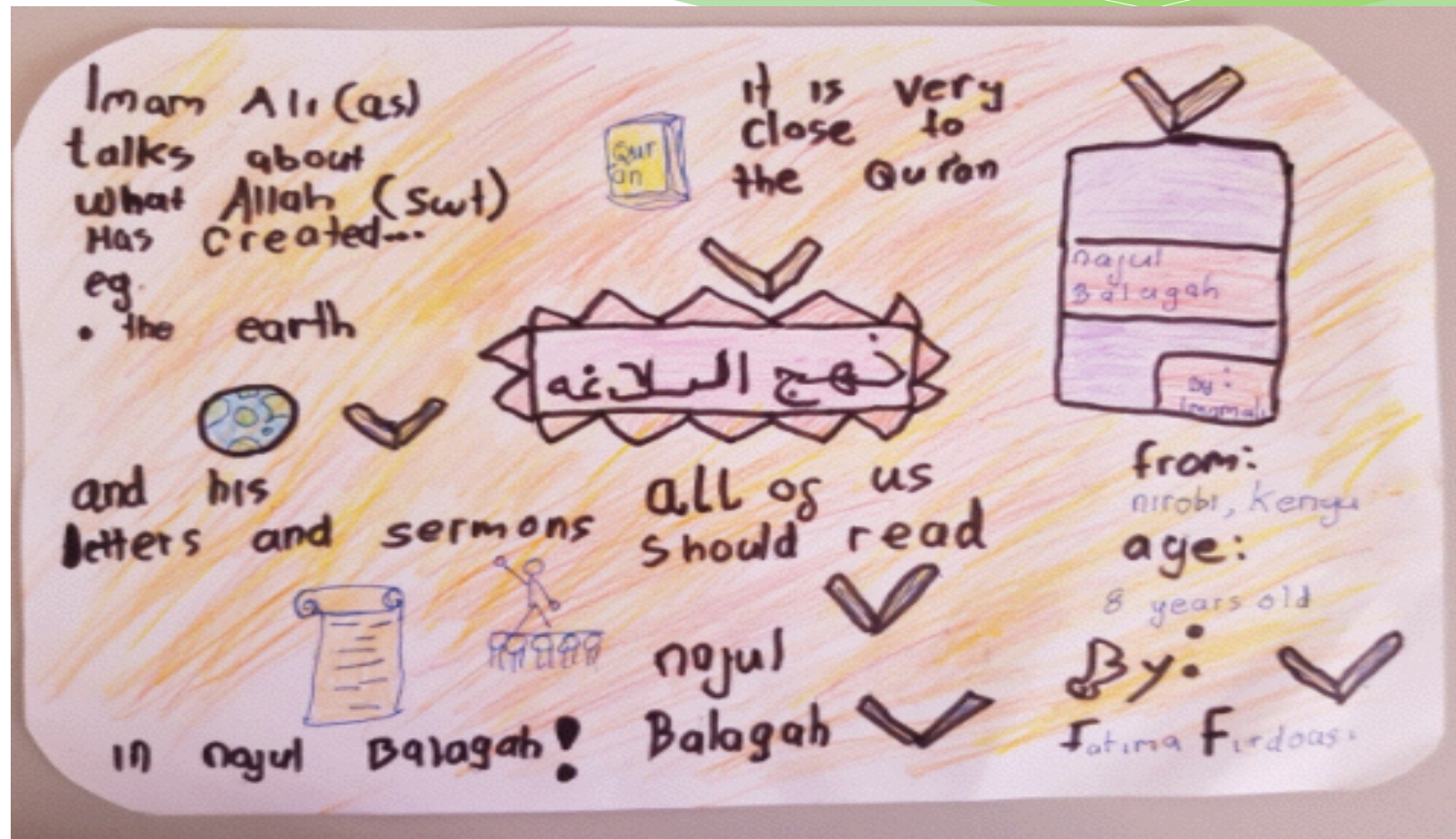




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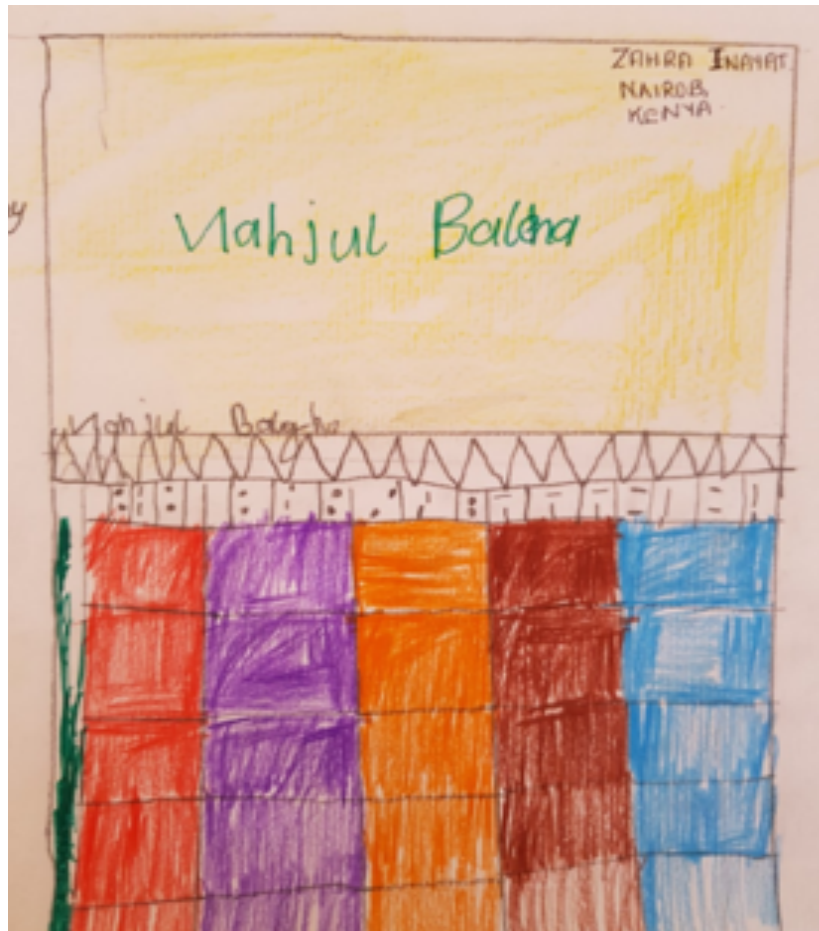

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# Taking a Closer Look at the Jewels in Nahjul Balagha-Hadith 333

- \* **Description of a believer:**
- \* Amir al-mu'minin, peace be upon him, said describing a believer: A believer has a **cheerful face**, a **sorrowful heart**, a very broad chest (**full of generosity**), and a very **humble heart**. He **hates high position** and **dislikes renown**. His grief is long, his **courage is far-reaching**, his **silence is much** and, his time is occupied. He is **grateful**, **enduring**, **buried in his thoughts**, **sparing in his friendship (with others)**, of bright demeanour and of **soft temperament**. He is **stronger than stone** but **humbler than a slave**.



# Taking a Closer Look at the Jewels in Nahjul Balagha-Saying 8

- \* "Man is truly a wonderful creature, he **sees through layers of fat**, he **hears through a bone**, he **speaks through a lump of flesh**."
- \* Description Given by Student:
- \* I think this is an interesting quote of Imam Ali because a lot of people think science and religion are different, but right hear it clearly says an Imam of Islam knows about "advanced science"

# Taking a Closer Look at the Jewels in Nahjul Balagha-Letter Imam Ali (AS) wrote to Muawiyyah

- \* “Fear Allah regarding what you have amassed and find out your true right therein, and turn to understand for what you will not be excused on the grounds of ignorance. Certainly, for (following the path of) obedience there are clear signs, shining ways, straight highways and a fixed aim.”
- \* Description Given by Student:
- \* I found this very interesting because he is saying you should fear Allah.
- \* -When referring to fearing of Allah SWT it refers to the fear of displeasing him when we do bad actions.

# Taking a Closer Look at the Jewels in Nahjul Balagha-Sermon 143 and 160

## **Position of the Ahlul-Bayt, Sermon 143**

Where are those who falsely and unjustly claimed that they are deeply versed in knowledge, as against us, although Allah raised us in position and kept them down, bestowed upon us knowledge, but deprived them and entered us, but kept them out. With us guidance is to be sought and blindness is to be changed into brightness. Surely Imam will be from the Quraysh. They have been planted in this line through Hashim. It would not suit others nor would others be suitable as heads of affairs.

## **Drawing Lessons From This World, Sermon 160**

I trust in Allah, the trust of bending towards him and I seek His guidance for the way that leads to His paradise and takes to the place of his pleasure. I advise you, O creatures of Allah, to exercise fear of Allah and to obey him because it is salvation tomorrow and deliverance forever. He warned and did so thoroughly. He persuaded and did so fully. He described this world, its cutting away from you, its decay and its shifting. Therefore, keep aloof from its attractions because very little of it will accompany you. This house is the closest to the displeasure of Allah and the remotest from the pleasure of Allah.

## THE ANT

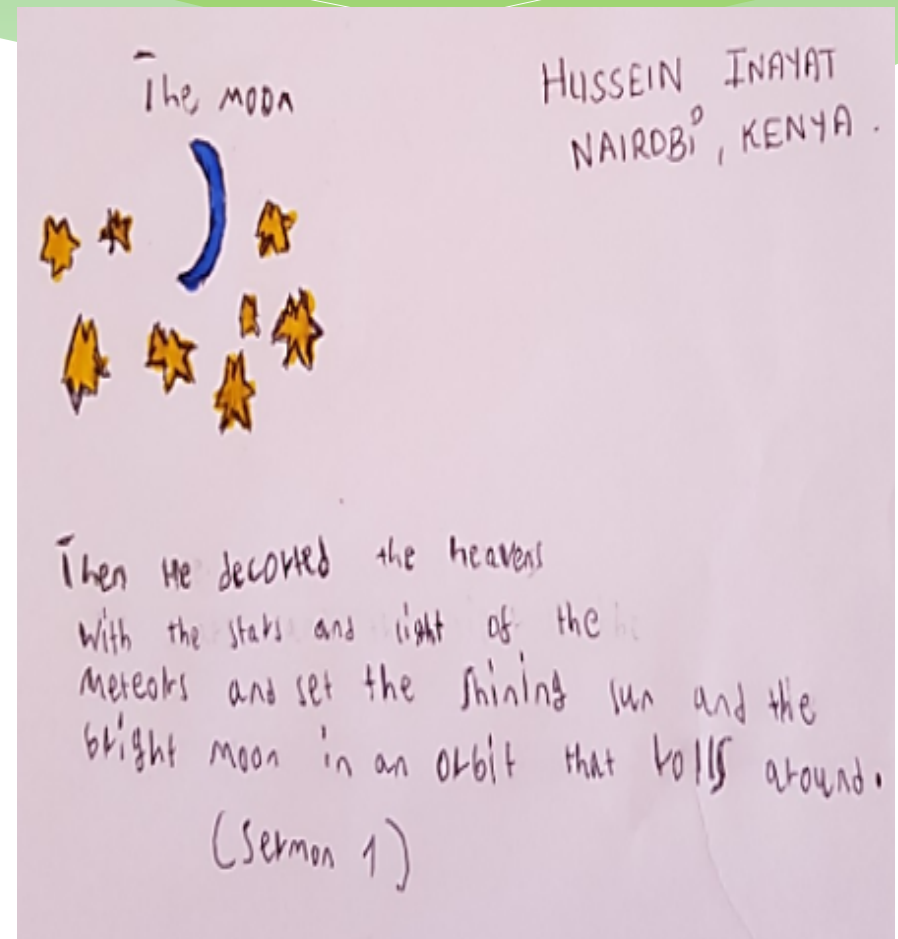
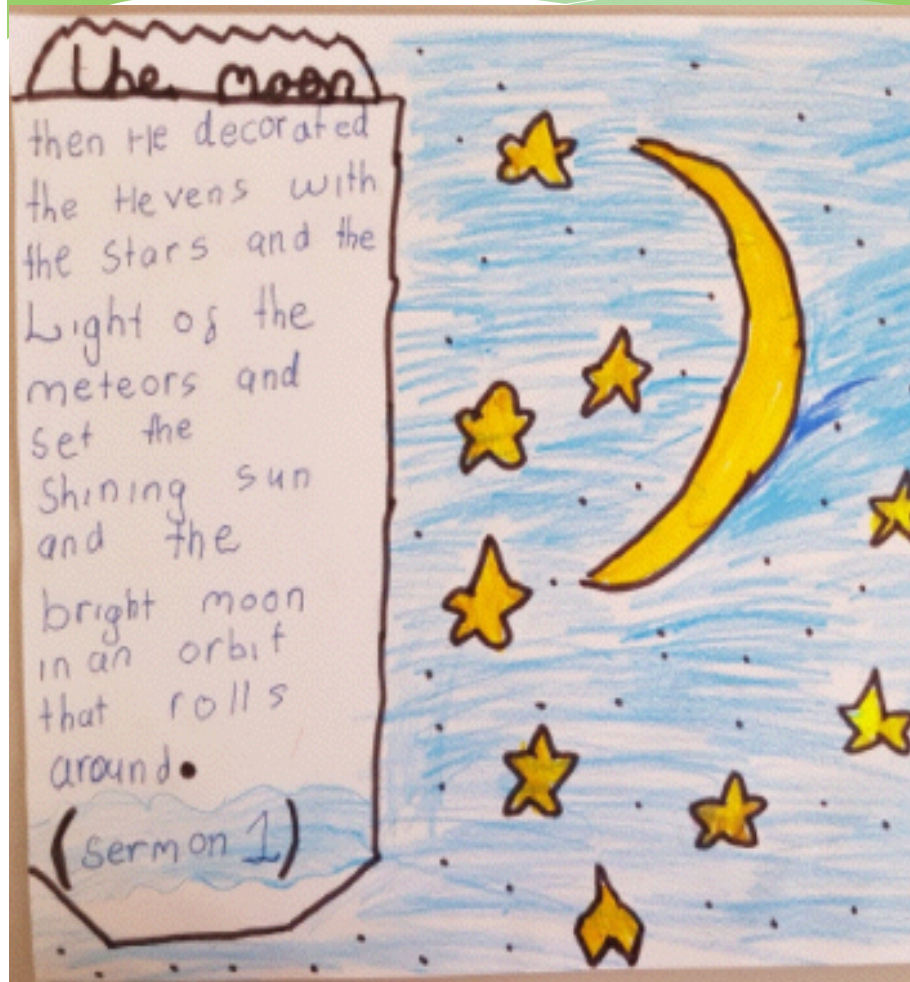
Look at the ant,

Revisiting a Commonly Asked Question from Last Week's Discussion:  
“Why did Muhammad bin Husayn change his name to Sharif ar-Radhi?”

- \* Muhammad bin Husayn was his real name
- \* Sharif ar Radhi was the title given to him
- \* The title 'al-Sharif' was a common title used for those who were descendants of the Prophet (PBUH) from both the maternal and paternal sides (now commonly used for al-Sharif is al-Sayyid)

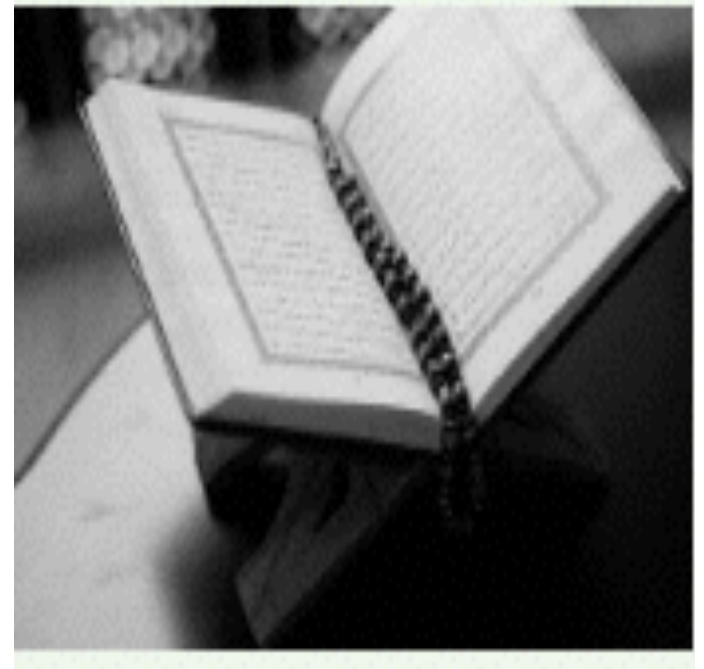

# Holy Qur'an in Nahjul Balagha

- Imam Ali (a) spoke about the Qur'an and often quoted from it
- Holy Prophet had said about Imam Ali (a), "Ali is with the Qur'an and the Qur'an is with 'Ali'. They will not separate until they reach the fountain (of Kauthar) on the Day of Judgement"
- Imam Ali (a) was known as the Qur'an an'Natiq (the Qur'an that speaks)



# Khutba (sermon 176) -Referring to the Holy Qur'an

- In khutba (sermon) no. 176 he says:

- “It contains a cure for the biggest diseases namely unbelief, hypocrisy, revolt and misguidance”

What do I understand from the khutba?

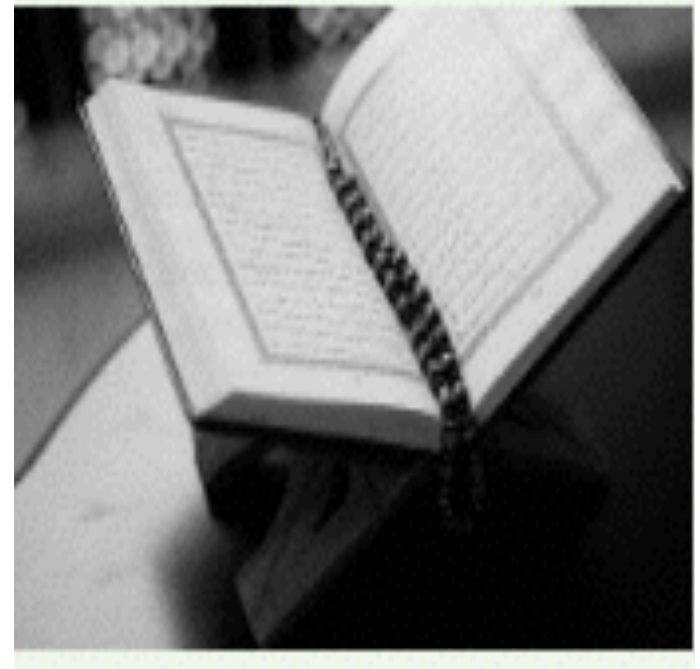
- Reference to Surat Yūnus, No. 10, Ayat 57

- يَا أَيُّهَا النَّاسُ قَدْ جَاءَكُمْ مَوْعِظَةٌ مِنْ رَبِّكُمْ وَشِفَاءٌ لِمَا فِي الصُّدُورِ وَهُدًى وَرَحْمَةٌ لِّلْمُؤْمِنِينَ

O mankind, There has certainly come to you an **advice** from your Lord, and a **cure** for what is in the chests, and a **guidance**, and a **mercy** for the believers.

# Meanings of the Holy Qur'an

- The Holy Qur'an has an outer meaning (Dhahir of the Qur'an)
- It also has an inner meaning (batin of the Qur'an)
- Lots of depth in the meaning of the Qur'an (explanation of the Qur'an as taught by the Masumeen (a) can be found in tafsir)
- Imam has explained that the Qur'an was not created for one time only and it is deep for all people until the Day of Judgement

# Hadith in Najul Balagha

- Hadith are the words of the Holy Prophet (s) and the Masumeen (a) that were narrated by those who heard them and later written down for Muslims to benefit from it
- Hadith are like pearls, precious and valuable whoever follows it will get good in this world and in the Hereafter
- The third part of Najul Balagha contains short Ahadith (plural of Hadith)

Meet people in such a way that if you die they should weep over you and if you live they should long for your company.

The doer of good is better than good and the doer of evil is worse than the evil.

3


The sin that displeases you is liked better by Allah than the good deed that makes you proud.

Contentment is wealth that does not decrease.

5

The people of the world are like travelers who are being carried while they sleep.
