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## The Holy Quran

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# What is society

Society represents a group of human beings, who, under the compulsion of a series of requirements and under the influence of a set of beliefs, ideals and goals, are amalgamated with one another and are immersed in a continuum of collective life.

Ayatollah Mutahhari, Sociology of the Quran

### The Ummah

- The Ummah refers to a group of people who share a common religion, or a common time or place
- The Quran talks about the Ummah as a group of people with a collective life. (6:108, 7:34, 10:47, 45:28)
- The Qur'an puts forward the idea of a common history, a common destiny, a common record of deeds, a common consciousness, understanding, sensibility and a common conduct for the ummahs. (Ayatullah Mutahhari, Sociology of the Quran)

In the Qur'anic exegesis, al-Mizan, it is argued that if a society has a single soul and the same social thinking, it is as if a single individual. In this case, members of society are like the bodily organs and faculties of one organism, intrinsically and physically united, and are amalgamated in the form of a single human personality in thought and action. Their pleasures and pains are like the pleasures and pains of one person and their bliss and adversities are like the bliss and adversities of one person.

(Ayatullah Mutahhari, Sociology of the Quran, quoting from al Mizan Vol.4)
