O mankind! Be wary of your Lord who created you from a single soul, and created its mate from it, and from the two of them scattered numerous men and women. Be wary of Allah, in whose Name you adjure one another and [of severing ties with] relations. Indeed Allah is watchful over you.

Points from the verse

- Taqwa is the foundation for society and all the rules for its progress.
- The verse shows equality, between genders, races . . . all forms of differences that may have crept into society. Everyone's origin is the same.
- A single soul refers to the human being from whom all were created
 Nabí Adam (a).
- Creation of the mate from it means from the same type, not from the person. Other verses also refer to this (30:21, 16:72)

Sura Hud, verse 116

Why were there not among the generations before you possessors of virtue who would forbid corruption in the earth, except a few of those whom We delivered from among them? Those who were wrongdoers pursued that in which they had been granted affluence, and they were a guilty lot.

Points from this verse

- Every society should have a group of people to counter corruption. This group saves the society from being destroyed.
- Past societies were destroyed because there were not many who stood up against corruption. Examples are the people of Nabi Nuh, Nabi Salih . . . etc. They were not able to reform society.
- Affluence intoxicated the people and prevented them from following the truth.
- There will be oppression and corruption in every society. But there must be some defence against it (like the white cells in the body). When these are absent the disease destroys everybody.

The 'Ulu Baqiyyatin'

- Literally means those who remain
- Those who have quality and are long lasting
- They are stronger and more insightful
- The title of the twelfth Imam is Baqiyyatullah one who is from Allah and will remain to spread
 justice on earth and overcome corruption.
