Familiarization with Quranic Suras Month of Ramadan 1439 – Day 7

Brief Info

Sura al-Munafiqun, No. 63. Revealed in Madinah, 11 verses.

Sura Significance

Whoever recites Sura Munafiqun will remain free from all forms of hypocrisy

- Holy Prophet 🏨

<u>Note:</u> Quranic Scholars say that the benefit is connected to the contents of the Surah and requires that recitation be done with awareness, comprehension, reflection and having an intention of implementation.

Synopsis of contents

- The signs of a hypocrite, manifested in attitude, speech and behaviour (vv. 1-4)
- Warning believers to be wary of the hypocrites in society (vv. 5-8)
- Reminder to the believers not to be deluded by the material pleasures of the world (v. 9)
- An invitation to spend in the way of Allah before death overtakes you (vv. 10-11)

Some Lessons from the Sura

- 1) The words of the hypocrites do not carry any value.
- 2) Hypocrites are often appealing in their speech and behavior.
- 3) Wealth and honor are from Allah, not from people.
- 4) Wealth and children can be distractions from the remembrance of Allah.
- 5) The approach of death can be a time of regrets. Avoid that by acting while still alive.

Suggested verses for memorization in Arabic and English

1) 63:9 - O you who have faith! Do not let your possessions and children distract you from the remembrance of Allah, and whoever does that—it is they who are the losers.

2) 63:11 - And Allah will never respite anyone when his time has come, and Allah is well aware of what you do
