Familiarization with Quranic Suras Month of Ramadan 1439 – Day 27

Brief Info Sura al-Tur, No. 52 Revealed in Makkah, 49 verses.

Sura Significance

Whoever recites the Sūra al-Tur it is incumbent on Allah to keep him safe from His punishment and favour him with Heaven - Holy Prophet

Imam Muhammad al-Bāqir said: Whoever recites sūra al-Tur Allah will combine for him the good of the world and the Hereafter.

<u>Note:</u> Quranic Scholars say that the reward is connected to the contents of the Surah and requires that recitation be done with awareness, comprehension, reflection and having an intention of implementation.

Synopsis of contents

The central theme of the sūra is the reward and punishment of the Hereafter.

- The sūra starts with certain oaths and then a discussion on coming of the Day of Judgment and the punishment of the Hereafter (vv. 1-16)
- Rewards of the Hereafter (vv. 17-24)
- A conversation in Heaven (vv. 25-28)
- Accusations against the Holy Prophet (vv. 29-34)
- The signs of Allah 🍇 (vv. 35-43)

Some Lessons from the Sura

- 1) People who spent their lives in amusement and sport will face the consequences in the Hereafter.
- 2) Families who believe will be united in the Hereafter (v. 21)
- 3) Conversations in the Hereafter will include discussions about life in the world.
- 5) Knowing that Allah is with us and watching what is happening helps a believer be patient (v. 48)

Suggested verses for memorization in Arabic and English

1) 52:48-49 - And wait patiently for the judgment of your Lord, for surely you are before Our eyes, and sing the praise of your Lord when you rise. And in the night, give Him glory too, and at the setting of the stars.

Activities for self-study

- 1) What are the questions Allah & asks the disbelievers in this sūra? (vv. 35-43). What concepts does He want them to think about?
- 2) The last two verses are a reassurance for the Prophet, and for believers. What are the different recommendations in these verses?
