Sūra Information

Sūra Muddaththir, No.74, Revealed in Makkah, 56 verses This sūra was revealed at the beginning of the period when the Prophet was told to announce his mission publicly.

Sūra Significance

Whoever recites Sūra al-Muddaththir in his obligatory prayers, it is on Allah to keep him in the company of Muhammad عَنْيَانُهُ, and he will not face misfortune in the world. Imam al-Bāqir المَنْيَةُ (Tafsīr Majm'ul-Bayān)

Synopsis of contents

- 1) Preparing for announcing the word of God
- 2) Details of the hereafter
- 3) Condition of the people in hell
- 4) Oaths to emphasize the truthfulness of the resurrection
- 5) The Quran as a reminder

Some Lessons from the Sūra

- 1) Spreading the word of God to others requires patience (verse 7)
- 2) The Day of Judgment will be a difficult day for those who did not have faith (verse 10)
- 3) Human being is always greedy for more (verses 11-15)
- 4) One of the reasons people will give for being in Hell is indulging in vain talks and gossip while in the world (verse 45)
- 5) Paying heed to the message of God requires a tawfiq that comes from Him (verse 56)

Important Messages

- 1) Those who oppose faith think and plan out their sinister strategies.
- 2) Accusing the Quran of being magic is a proof that it was effective on the listeners.
- 3) Participating in gatherings of vain discourses will be a source of regret on the Day of Judgment.

4) Intercession will not be available for those who have taken salāt lightly and have disregarded the rights of the poor.

Select verses from the Sūra to know (learn, reflect, memorize)

1) 74:31 (part of the verse) - No one knows the hosts of your Lord except Him

2) 74:38 - Every soul is hostage to what it has earned

3) 74:43-47 – [the guilty would say]: We were not among those who prayed. Nor did we feed the poor. We used to indulge in [profane] gossip along with the gossipers, and we used to deny the Day of Retribution, until death came to us.

Activities for self-study

Verses 2-7 give instructions to the Prophet (s) on warning the people. What rules can you derive from these verses for spreading the word of God?
What attitudes of the rejecters of faith are revealed in verses 19-25?
