Sūrat Hud– Part 3 (verses 84-123)

Sūra Information

Sūrat Hūd, No.11, Revealed in Makkah, 123 verses.

Important Messages

- 1) On the Day of Judgment, no-one will speak except by the permission of Allah. (verse 105)
- 2) Every generation should have a group of wise people who forbid corruption on earth. (verse 116)
- 3) If Allah wanted, He could have made all of mankind one community. (verse 118)

Select verses from the Sūra to know (learn, reflect, memorize)

- 1) Q 11:85 *Observe fully the measure and the balance, with justice, and do not cheat the people of their goods, and do not act wickedly on the earth, causing corruption.*
- 2) Q 11:86 *What remains of Allah's provision is better for you, should you be faithful.*
- 3) Q 11:112 *So be steadfast, just as you have been commanded.*
- 4) Q 11:114 *Maintain the prayer at the two ends of the day, and during the early hours of the night. Indeed, good deeds efface misdeeds. That is an admonition for the mindful.*

Activities for self-study

- 1) Write out the conversation of Prophet Shu'ayb عليه السلام with his people (verses 84-93). What are some things he tries to make them understand? How do they respond?
- 2) Read verse 120. What does it tell you about the effects of the Quran?
