

Dua to thank Allah

Human beings can never thank Allah adequately for all the benefits He has blessed them with. Certain dua's however show us how we can try to thank Allah, albeit insufficiently. According to Imam Ja'far as-Sadiq (a), the following du'a was recited by Prophet Nuh (a) ten times in the morning and ten times at night, to thank Allah. That is why he was called 'a grateful servant'.

For the Morning

مِنْ نِعْمَةٍ وَ عَافِيَةٍ فِي دِينٍ أَوْ دُنْيَا
فَمِنْكَ وَحْدَكَ لَا شَرِيكَ لَكَ
لَكَ الْحَمْدُ وَ لَكَ الشُّكْرُ بِهَا عَلَيَّ
حَتَّى تَرْضَى وَ بَعْدَ الرِّضَى

O Allah, I call You to witness that whatever I have this morning of favors and well-being, of religion or of the world, then they are from You, there is no partner for You. For You is all praise, and for You is all thanks for it, Until You are pleased, and beyond that.

For the Night
