


Introduction 1

- Malake What is it?
- When a person performs any action, it casts a shadow on his soul
- Repetition over a long time causes the effect of the action to penetrate the soul.
- At this point he becomes that action.
- This is true for both positive traits and negative traits.


Introduction 1

- How can taqwa become a malake
- Man attaches his heart through intellect and accepts that his beginning is Allah (s) and his end is Allah (s) so therefore:
 - Actions are performed according to Allah (s) commands
 - These actions cast a light on the soul, and have effects
 - And this strengthens the imaan [belief]
 - Repetition of the actions according to sharia makes the imaan stronger
 - And the effects on the soul get stronger
 - This relationship between imaan and actions is called taqwa
 - Taqwa has become malake when performing these actions is easy for them




So taqwa is a malake which one gains due to having a continuous imaan and actions which are constant (repeated).
