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# Quran on receiving 700 times reward

﴿مَثَلُ الَّذِينَ يُنْفِقُونَ أَمْوَالَهُمْ فِي سَبِيلِ اللَّهِ كَمَثَلِ حَبَّةٍ أَنْبَتَتْ سَبْعَ سَنَابِلٍ فِي كُلِّ سُنْبُلَةٍ مِئَةٌ حَبَّةٌ وَاللَّهُ يُضَاعِفُ لِمَنْ يَشَاءُ وَاللَّهُ وَاسِعٌ عَلِيمٌ﴾.

Q 2:261 *The parable of those who spend their wealth in the way of Allah is that of a grain which grows seven ears, in every ear a hundred grains. Allah enhances severalfold whomever He wishes, and Allah is all-bounteous, all-knowing.*

Imam al-Sādiq عليه السلام used the above verse to say that Allah has bestowed mu'minān a special honor by rewarding them 700 times for all good deeds: *When a believing servant does good, Allah multiplies for him his deed - for every deed seven hundred times.*

## Chpt 2: Exclusive honors that Allah has reserved for Believers

وقال: إِنَّ الْمُؤْمِنِينَ لِيَلْتَقِيَانِ فَيَتَصَافِحَانِ، فَلَا يَزَالُ اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِمَا مُقْبِلًا بِوَجْهِهِ،  
وَالذُّنُوبُ تَتَحَاتُّ عَنْ وُجُوهِهِمَا حَتَّى يَفْتَرِقَا.

Imam al-Sādiq عليه السلام: When two believers meet and shake hands, Allah does not cease looking at them and their sins continue to fall off them until they part.

Abu Ja‘far عليه السلام: O Malik, when a believer meets his brother (in faith) and shakes his hand, Allah does not stop gazing at them; and sins continue to fall off them until they part without any sins on them. How then can you possibly describe one who is (of) such (a status before Allah).
