# Meanings of Sahar and suhūr

The word أَسْحَارٌ both appear in the Quran. In Q 54:34, Allah عَلَيْهِمْ مَاصِبًا إِلَّا آلَ لُوطِ مِنْكُمْ بِسَحَرٍ says إِنَّا أَرْسَلْنَا عَلَيْهِمْ حَاصِبًا إِلَّا آلَ لُوطِ مِنْكُمْ بِسَحَرٍ • We unleashed upon them a rain of stones, excepting the family of Lot, whom We delivered at dawn. And in Q 3:17 Allah says:

الصَّابِرِينَ وَالصَّادِقِينَ وَالْمُنفِقِينَ وَلِي الْمُنفِقِينَ وَلَمُ اللْمُنفِقِينَ وَلَعِلْمُ الْمُنفِقِينَ وَالْمُنفِقِينَ وَالْمُنفِقِينَ وَالْمُنفِقِينَ وَالْمُنفِقِينَ وَالْمُنْفِقِينَ وَالْمُنْفِيقِينَ وَلْمُنْفِيقِينَ وَلِي الْمُنفِقِينَ وَلِي الْمُنفِقِينَ وَلَوْلِي الْمُنفِيقِينَ وَلِي الْمُنْفِقِينَ وَلِيْلِي الْمُ

[They are] patient and truthful, obedient and charitable, and they plead for [Allah's] forgiveness at dawns.

So, from the translation of these verses Sahar means 'dawn'. However, our scholars tell us, based on Hadith, that the Sahar time when we are asked to say tahajjud salat, recite Du'ās and munājāt and preform tasbih is the last one third of the night.

Suhūr is the food and drink we take at Sahar with an intention of beginning a fast.

## What do we do at Sahar in Ramadan?

Imam Muhammad al-Bāqir says that the Holy Prophet broke his fast and had his early morning meal with two black things. When asked what they were, he replied: dates and water, and raisins and water. (Rayshahrī, *Shahrullāh fil-kitab walsunnah*, H 330)

It is recommended to recite Sūrat al-Qadr when taking Suhūr and Iftār. A believer who recites Sūrat al-Qadr when taking Suhūr and Iftār has a reward of a martyr in a Hadith. (Ibid, H 332)

In *al-Tahdhīb*: . . from Abū 'Abdillāh <sup>1</sup> who said: When the Holy Month of Ramadan would come, the Prophet <sup>1</sup> increased his salah and I too increase it (in the month of Ramadan) so you should also increase it (Tabātabā'ī, *Sunan an-Nabi*, p. 151)
