



ALI 702: Quranic Arabic & Knowledge, Level 1

Session 2: Wednesday Aug 12, 2025; 6:30 – 7:30 pm pm NY/Toronto time.

Description: Quranic Arabic helps Muslims learn the language of the Quran with a goal of comprehending the Divine message directly. In this online course, specially tailored for past and present Madrasah teachers, we will learn simple Quranic vocabulary and grammar. To make it interesting, occasionally we plan to cover simple rules of Tajweed, stories and historical events in the Quran and the relevance of the Quran in our daily lives. Participants will need to put in an average of two hours a week to work on the course. In this level, we will identify nouns and their different forms, a few verbs, and particles from the Sūras recited in daily prayers. Texts: The Phrase-by-Phrase English Translation of the Quran by Syed Ali Quli Qarai, and Qur'anic Language Made Easy by Hafiza Iffath Hasan.

Course Outline: A quick review of lessons and homework for Session 1. Lessons 3 and 4 on detached and attached pronouns. Highlighting the two types of the pronouns in sūrahs al-Fātihah, al-Tāwhīd, al-Kawthar and al-ʿAsr. Use of diacritical marks to indicate long vowels.

Sūrat al-Qadr – سُوْرَةُ الْقَدْرِ

The following sūrah has been copied from www.tanzil.net

<u>Translation</u>: In the Name of Allah, the All-beneficent, the All-merciful. Indeed, We sent it down on the Night of Ordainment. (1) And what will show you what is the Night of Ordainment? (2) The Night of Ordainment is better than a thousand months. (3) In it the angels and the Spirit descend, by the leave of their Lord, with every command. (4) It is peaceful until the rising of the dawn. (5)

Prophet Muhammad :: He who recites it (Sūrat al-Qadr) will be rewarded like someone who fasted Ramadan and has kept vigil on the night of al-Qadr. (Majma' al-Bayān 10:516)

Answer to HW, Q 2, Session 1

Bismillāh. Mustahab prayers in which reciting Sūrat al-Qadr is mustahab:

- 1) Salāt for the 1st night of an Islamic month, recite in the 1st rak'ah after Sūrat al-Fātihah 30 times al-Tawhīd and after the 2nd rak'ah, recite 30 times al-Qadr. After the prayers offer charity, which will InshāAllah assure your safety for that month.
- 2) In **Salāt of Hadiyah Mayyit** (gift to a deceased believer), recite after al-Fātiah, al-Qadr in the first rak'ah and al-Kawthar in the second.
- 3) In the **Salāt of Wahshat** which is recited by the relatives on the first night after the burial. In the first Rak'ah after al-Fatihah, recite Ayat al-Kursi once; and in the second rak'ah, recite al-Qadr 10 times. After the prayer say: O Allah bless Muhammad and the family of Muhammad, and send the reward of this prayer to grave of so and so (. . . وَابْعَتْ ثُوَابِعَا إِلَىٰ قَبَرٍ . . .) Mention the name of the deceased.

Please note that there are numerous Hadith on the *fadhīlat* (excellence and merits) of reciting Sūrat al-Qadr. May Allah grant us *tawfīq* (success) to recite it often.

Answer to HW, Q 3, Session 1

Bismillāh. Lessons that can be derived from the Du'a before tialwah. If we read the Du'a with translation and reflection we can notice the following points:

- 1, addressing to Allah directly and confessing that the Quran is Allah's covenant & pledge (اَللَّهُمَّ اِنِيّ نَشَرْتُ عَهْدَكَ) and His scripture (وَكِتَابَكَ)
- 2, make my looking at it as worship (فَاجْعَلْ نَظْرِي فِيْهِ عِبَادَةً) Imam al-Sadiq's response to someone who asked if he should recite the Quran from memory or by looking at the scrolls (mushaf)? The origin of Quranic calligraphy in holy places.
- 3, our recitation should be full of contemplation and reflection (وَقِرَ آئَتِي فِيْهِ فِكْرًا)
- 4, derive admonitions & lessons when reflecting upon Quranic verses (وَفِكْرِيْ فِيْهِ اِعْتِبَارًا)
- 5, do not make my tilawah a mere quick recitation (وَلاَ تَجُعُل قِرَآئَتِي قِرَآئَةً لاَ تَدُبُّرَ فِيْهَا)
- 6, look for Divine signs and laws (بَلِ اجْعَلْنِي اَتَدَبَّرُ آيَاتِهِ وَأَحْكَامِهِ)
- 7, Indeed, Allah will provide all the above as He is Kind and Merciful.
