



ALI 707: Quranic Arabic & Knowledge, Level 2

Wednesdays Sep 24 – Oct 29, 2025; 8 – 9 pm NY/Toronto time.

Description: Imam Muhammad al-Baqir (a) has said: Learn Arabic, for it is the word of Allah with which He speaks to His creation [in the Holy Quran]. In this online course, specially tailored for past and present Madrasah teachers, we will discuss simple Quranic vocabulary and grammar. To make it interesting, occasionally we will cover short stories and historical events in the Quran and their application in our daily lives. In this level, we will identify nouns and their different forms, a few verbs, and particles from Surahs Numbers 108 to 114 of the Quran.

<u>Texts</u>: The Phrase-by-Phrase English Translation of the Quran by Syed Ali Quli Qarai, and Qur'anic Language Made Easy by Hafiza Iffath Hasan.

Surat al-Fatihah/al-Hamd

سُوْرَةُ الْفَاتِحَةِ

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَٰنِ الرَّحِيمِ ﴿ اللَّهِ الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ رَبِّ الْعَالَمِينَ ﴿ الرَّحِيمِ ﴿ ٢﴾ مَالِكِ يَوْمِ الدِّينَ ﴿ ٤﴾ إِيَّاكُ نَعْبُدُ

Fadhīlat (excellence) of al-Fatihah

- Only surah named on account its position/location in the Quran. It is al-Fatiha because it is the opening chapter of the Quran, as well as the opening of the prayers.
- Only surah to be revealed twice, once in Makkah and then in Madinah
- only surah in which *basmalah* is counted as part of the surah. *Basmalah* is the name of the opening verse (بِسْمِ الله الرَّحمٰنِ الرَّحِيْمِ) of all but one sūrahs of the Quran
- One of its names *al-Sab' al-mathani*, i.e., the seven oft repeated verses. It termed so because it was revealed twice, and it is recited twice in every prayer.
- Prophet has said that for prayers to be valid, al-Fatihah must be recited in it.
- Prophet : God, the Almighty informed me, "I have divided the Fatihat al-Kitab between me and my servants; half of it is for Me and half of it is for My servant, and my sevant shall receive whatever he asks for."
- Surah al-Fatihah is the only surah which is obligatory upon every Muslim to recite at least ten times daily in his five obligatory prayers.
